

A Comparison of Kelp Distribution Mapped in 1979 with Aerial Photography and in 1995 with a Digital Multispectral Imager


In August 1995, Borstad Associates mapped an area of extensive kelp beds in the Nootka Sound area on west coast of Vancouver Island, for the British Columbia Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food.
